Soft, warm and smooth red with lots of blackcurrant and plum fruits and a dash of spice. 2010
- 17. Whispering Hills Merlot, California, USA** £13.50
Typically soft and juicy with ripe berry fruit flavours and supple tannins. 2010
- 18. Campo Reale Nero d'Avola Sicilia, Rapitalà, Italy** £14.50
Fragrant floral aromas of dark cherries, cloves and spice with smooth Sicilian red fruit. 2008
- 19. Marqués de Morano Rioja Tinto, Spain** £3.75 £5.25 £14.95
A lighter style for Rioja, just a hint of traditional oakiness and abundant juicy ripe berries. 2009

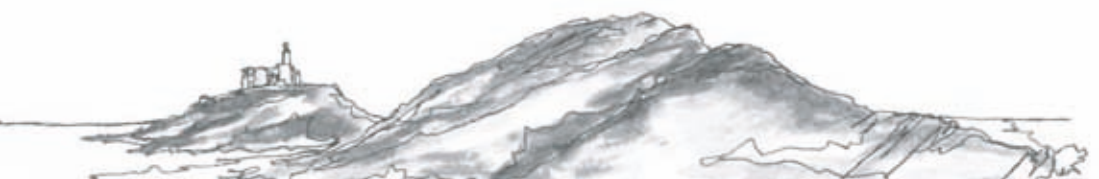
- 20. Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France, France** £15.50
From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice. 2010
- 21. Cape 1652 Pinotage, Western Cape, South Africa** £15.50
Smooth, soft and rich blackcurrant with a nice splattering of spice on the juicy finish. 2009
- 22. Marquise des Tours Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon Dulong, Bordeaux, France** £19.00
Modern appealing Bordeaux with bright blackcurrant fruit and soft cherries - smooth, round and soft. 2009
- 23. Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Spain** £19.95
Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character. 2006

SPICY, PEPPERY, WARMING REDS

- 25. Caluri Cannonau Sardegna, Italy** £14.95
The grape is better known as Grenache shows a soft, warm, spicy character and a rich berry fruit flavour. 2008
- 26. Errázuriz Carmenère, Aconcagua Valley, Chile** £19.50
Full and flavoursome, made with Chile's 'own' grape variety. It has a rich, spicy flavour and firm, ripe tannins. 2010
- 27. Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia, Australia** £3.50 £4.50 £13.50
Medium-bodied and fruity with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices. 2010
- 28. Robert Mondavi Twin Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA** £16.50
The long, dry and very hot late summers allow lovely flavours to develop. Vibrant redcurrants and a spiced oak balance. 2009

OAKED, INTENSE, CONCENTRATED REDS

Traditional Rioja with a stylish, silky balance of ripe cherry flavours and generous vanilla oak character for a mature style. 2004

Modern-styled with spicy, red-berry fruit aromas with lovely integration of warm tannins and soft blackcurrant fruit. 2009
- 31. Errázuriz Cabernet Sauvignon Founder's Reserve, Don Maximiano Estate, Aconcagua Valley, Chile** £49.95
With great deference to the old vines, this concentrated richness and power-packed abundance of blackcurrant richness, delivers a mouth full of elegance. 2007
